Hurricane Sandy’s path of damage is widespread, as is the response of MDS volunteers. They are currently working in Staten Island where volunteers come in for the day, work, and then return home. At the present time there are no overnight volunteers, as this would put strain on an already over-loaded infrastructure.

Tree removal and clean up plans are being made for Rhode Island and Connecticut and MDS volunteers from units in several other states are responding locally to clean up and repair needs. MDS accepts monetary donations to support the clean up work in all areas affected by Hurricane Sandy. MDS does not accept donations of food and other items.
